

Summer Reading Program



- Schedule: Mon. - Fri., 9 am - 12 pm
- Period: July 9 - August 24, 2018
- Fee: \$350 per week * \$330 for Civic Holiday Week

Summer is the perfect time to catch up on reading and get ahead of peers. Students will read short stories, novels, and other written works. The focus of the classes is on reading, so projects, tasks, and assignments will be tailored to demonstrating their understanding of the stories. Students will also learn a lot of vocabulary, which is essential to reading properly, and which will help with their writing skills as well. Other topics include elements of literature and literary devices.



Creative Writing & Drama


- Schedule: Mondays, 12:30-2:30 pm
- Period: July 9 - August 24, 2018
- Fee: \$330

Creative-writing classes focus on studying the literary techniques employed by well-known modern authors. Topics include creating hooks, developing characters, and writing imagery. Technical aspects of writing, such as literary devices and employing dialogue, are also discussed. In drama classes, students will read, cast, and stage scenes from various popular works. Students will learn acting techniques, including voice projection and body movement.




Problem Solving in Math

- Schedule: Thursdays, 12:30-2:30 pm
- Period: July 9 - August 24, 2018
- Fee: \$385




Students will enjoy solving various math problems in this class. Topics include word problems and application puzzles. Refresher lessons will give students a review of basic math skills and ask them to apply these skills to find solutions.



The Joy of Science

- Schedule: Tuesdays, 12:30-2:30 pm
- Period: July 9 - August 24, 2018
- Fee: \$385

It's time to experiment! The joy of science is often overlooked in regular school, but summer is the time to figure out how things work and why reactions happen. Classes will focus on experiments within the branches of chemistry, biology, and physics.



Study Skills

THE FOUNDATION FOR LIFELONG LEARNING

This class focuses on skills and knowledge not generally covered in school. Students will learn how to take notes properly, organize their ideas, memorize information efficiently, and use logic to solve a variety of puzzles. Each class will focus on a different topic, though skills taught in previous classes will also be reinforced.

Hand Lettering

- Schedule: Fridays, 12:30-2:30 pm
- Period: July 9 - August 24, 2018
- Fee: \$ 385 + \$15 (materials)



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Learn how to make lettered pieces of art. This is a beginner's lettering class, which will focus on basic strokes, colour combinations, and composition using faux-calligraphy, brush-lettering, and watercolour styles. Students will be guided on developing personal alphabets and artistic styles. There is a modest additional fee for this course to cover the cost of writing materials. Students will be able to keep their writing tools and projects at the end of the course.
